**25 Mile Race Start** – Races start at 11:00 a.m. Registration from 9:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Hamilton Bottom Boat Launch, Take Pine Creek (Route PA-44 North) exit of Route 220. Travel 12 miles north and continue straight onto Route PA-414 East for 2.3 miles. Look for Hamilton Bottom Boat Launch sign and turn right into boat launch parking area. **Finish** - Jersey Shore Boat Access (Rt. 44 Green Bridge). GPS Location: 41.202457,-77.252112. Awards will be presented at the finish. Registration at the start of race each day. *Note: Cutoff time indicated below.*

**8 Mile Race, 8 Mile Relay and 4 Mile Race Start** – Races start at 1 p.m. Registration at noon at the Whitetail Parking Area for the Pine Creek Rail Trail. Take Pine Creek (Route PA-44 North) exit of Route 220. Travel 2 miles north and turn left into the Whitetail Parking Area. The races will start at the Torbert Canoe Access Area on Furnace Run Rd.

**8 Mile Race, 8 Mile Relay Finish** - Jersey Shore Boat Access (Rt. 44 Green Bridge). GPS Location: 41.202457,-77.252112. Awards will be presented at the finish.

**4 Mile Race Finish** SUP and Youth – Former Tiadaghton Elm location at iron bridge on River Road. GPS Location: 41.180824,-77.278778. Awards will be presented at the Jersey Shore Rt. 44 bridge finish.
